Street Division crews are currently patching potholes citywide both proactively and by citizen request.

The fall residential sweeping cycle commenced on September 22, 2014. Prior to leaf drop, sweepers will work in areas of the city that have lower concentrations of trees and subsequently move into areas of high concentration as our trees begin to lose their leaves. Fall residential sweeping will continue until completion or weather conditions dictate the operation be suspended for the season. This generally occurs on or about December 1st of each year.

During the week of September 29, 2014, street sweepers will be operating in the following areas:

Kishwaukee St. west to River – Y Blvd. south to City Limits
Kishwaukee St. east to City Limits – Sandy Hollow south to City Limits
Harrison south to Sandy Hollow – 20TH St. east to Mulford Rd.

All Street Division Operations are dependent on existing weather conditions and are subject to change accordingly. Citizens are urged to approach Public Works Crews with caution and at a reduced speed that is below posted speed limits.

The City of Rockford appreciates your continued patience and cooperation as we perform our Street Maintenance Activities.



Residential Street Sweeping


Fall 2014 Cycle Overview
