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Traffic Signal Removal Study

On Wednesday, January 15th, weather permitting; the City will begin a study of the possible removal of the traffic signals at the following intersections:

- 15th Avenue & Christina Street
- 11th Street & Columbia Avenue

All signals will be shut off and bagged as part of the study. STOP signs will be installed on Christina Street and Columbia Avenue while 15th Avenue and 11th Street shall be allowed to flow freely. The signals will remain covered for at least 30 days as part of a study to determine the viability of removing the signals.

Users of these roadways shall use caution while entering the newly controlled intersections.

Questions regarding the signal removals should be directed to Jeremy Carter, City Traffic Engineer at the Public Works Department. Citizens are also encouraged to call with support or concerns regarding the possible signal removal.

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
