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Traffic Signal Removal Study

Based on the success with the previous traffic signal removals, the City will begin a study of the possible removal of the traffic signals at the following intersections (with the listed proposed traffic control signs):

- 15th Avenue and 7th Street (All-Way Stop)
- 15th Avenue and 9th Street (All-Way Stop)
- North Central Avenue and Old Amerock Building Entrance (Building Entrance stopping for Central Avenue)
- Seminary Street and Caitlin Street (Pedestrian Signals)

All signals will be shut off and bagged as part of the study. Signs warning of the traffic study will be installed in advance of the intersection at each leg. The signals will remain covered for at least 30 days as part of a study to determine the viability of removing the signals.

Users of these roadways should use caution while entering the newly controlled intersections.

Questions regarding the signal removals should be directed to Jeremy Carter, City Traffic Engineer at the Public Works Department. Citizens are also encouraged to call with support or concerns regarding the possible signal removal.

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
