### MESSAGE

On Monday October 28, 2013 around 3:30pm Rockford Police and Rockford Fire were sent to the intersection of S. Alpine Rd and Beach St for a vehicle versus a pedestrian traffic accident.

Initial investigation revealed a 60 year old male walked east from Beach St into the intersection of S. Alpine Rd. Southbound traffic had the green light. This male continued through the intersection and was struck by a southbound 2000 Oldsmobile Alero driven by a 56 year old female. The driver of the vehicle was not injured. The male was transported to a local hospital where he is listed in critical condition.

The Rockford Police Department's Traffic Investigations unit is conducting the follow up investigation.
