INFORMATION RELEASE

ROCKFORD, Ill. – The Rockford Police Department is seeking the public’s assistance in locating a wanted subject.

On July 9, 2013, Rockford Police officers were sent to the 600 block of Woodlawn Avenue at approximately 8:20 p.m. regarding a report of shots fired. Officers learned that there had been a fight between two groups and shots had been fired. Two individuals had been struck by gun fire. Both later died as a result of their injuries.

Detectives reviewed the investigation with the Winnebago County State’s Attorney’s Office who authorized a warrant for:

Narcellus H. Taylor B/M Age 41
Charge: Unlawful Use of Weapons by Felon

Taylor’s last known address was in the 7300 block of South Campbell in Chicago.
