ARREST RELEASE

On October 14th, 2016 at about 7pm, members of the Rockford Specialized Community Oriented Police Enforcement team, received information that a subject identified as 35 year old Rockford resident, Jesse Herbig, was at a residence in the 1900 block of South Fourth Street. Officers learned that Herbig was wanted on several warrants. Officers went to the residence and located Herbig and took him into custody. Herbig was found to be in possession of a quantity of narcotics. Herbig was charged with the following offenses:

Violation of the controlled Substances Act-Possession with Intent to Deliver
Aggravated Fleeing to Elude Warrant
Armed Habitual Criminal Warrant
Failure to Appear warrant

A photograph of Herbig is attached. He was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.

This is an on-going investigation. No further information is available at this time.

The charges against Herbig are merely accusations. Herbig should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
