MESSAGE

On Tuesday May 28th, 2013 shortly after 10:00 PM, members of the Rockford Police Department responded to the AMC Showplace Movie Theaters located in the 8300 block of E. State Street in reference to subject armed with a firearm. Upon arrival to the theaters, officers located Darryl Fultz, 29 years of age, with a loaded 9mm handgun on his person inside the movie theaters. After a brief struggle Fultz was taken into custody. Also located on the person of Fultz was suspected cannabis. Fultz was confirmed to have been convicted of a prior felony offense. Fultz is a member of the Waco Street gang. The firearm was confirmed to be stolen from Winnebago County in 2012. Fultz was charged with the following:

Darryl V. Fultz, 29 years of age, Rockford, Illinois
Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon
Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon
No FOID
Violation of the Cannabis Control Act
Resisting/Obstructing a Police Officer
Possession of Stolen Property

The charges against Fultz are merely accusations. He is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
