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CIP UPDATE

HARRISON AVENUE BRIDGE DECK REPLACEMENT

On May 12, 2014 construction began on Harrison Avenue Bridge for the deck replacement over the Rock River. Construction will start on the north side of the bridge first. Traffic will be shifted to the south side with one lane traffic each way. The Bridge will remain open to traffic, but be prepared for possible traffic delays. Construction will be completed by October 31, 2014. Please use caution when driving in the area.

BRIDGE RAILING REPAIRS – 2014

Beginning May 27, 2014 contractors will be replacing three bridge railings throughout the City as follows:

- N. Alpine Rd. north of Maray Dr. – North and southbound right lane closures.
- S. Alpine Rd. north of Larson Ave. – Northbound lane closure only.
- Applewood Ln. north of Springbrook Rd. – Single traffic lane only – Proceed with caution.

This work will be ongoing throughout the next 30 days. All lane closures will occur only during daytime hours.

US Bus 20 (FAP Rt. 303) – West State Street Sunset Avenue to West of Bridge Over Kent Creek Roadway Reconstruction

On May 5th Central Avenue was closed from West State Street to Elm Street. Please note that the West State Street and Central Avenue intersection, as well as the Elm Street and Central Avenue intersection, will remain open to traffic. The closure is expected to remain in place until early July.

US Bus 20 (FAP Rt. 303) – West State Street, Sunset Avenue to West of Bridge over Kent Creek, Roadway Reconstruction consists of the complete reconstruction and widening of Business Route 20 and the realignment of Jefferson Street. This includes pavement removal, excavation, PCC pavement, HMA pavement, curb and gutter, median, multi-use path and sidewalk construction, storm sewer installation, retaining wall construction, landscaping, street lighting, traffic signal modernization and interconnection, pavement markings, erosion control, maintenance of traffic and all other necessary to complete the improvements.

IL- 2 / South Main Street – Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Roadway Project (Beltline Road to 0.4 miles north of Harrison Avenue)

On May 8th South Main Street was closed between the intersections of Harrison Avenue and Iroquois Avenue. It will remain closed for two (2) weeks. Please note that the Harrison and South Main intersection will remain open to traffic. A detour will be posted.

The project consists of widening and resurfacing, pavement removal and replacement, adding lanes and a barrier median, curb and gutter, adding a bike path, providing right and left turn lanes, and installing lighting and traffic signals. IDOT will be coordinating with all applicable governmental agencies throughout the project. The project anticipated completion date is late 2014.

IL- 2 / South Main Street – Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Roadway Project (South of Pond Street to just North of Cedar Street)

Traffic has been reduced to one lane in each direction from Clifton Avenue to Knowlton Street so that underground utilities may be installed.

The project consists of pavement removal, excavation, roadway re-alignment, PCC pavement, HMA pavement, curb and gutter, landscaped median, multi-use path and sidewalk construction, storm sewer installation, landscaping, street lighting, traffic signal modernization and interconnection, pavement markings, erosion control, maintenance of traffic and all other necessary items to complete the improvements. The project completion date is late 2015.

IDOT will be coordinating with all applicable governmental agencies throughout the project.

Drivers are reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zone.

CITY WIDE STREET REPAIRS GROUP #1

On April 28th, 2014 construction work began on the City Wide Street Repairs Group #1 project. Work will consist of full width resurfacing with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) 10th Avenue from 14th Street to 15th Street
- 2) 14th Street from 10th Avenue to Woodruff Avenue
- 3) Dawson Avenue from East State Street to Greenwood Avenue
- 4) Brown Hills Road from Ridgewood Road to Greenmount Avenue
- 5) Burrmont Road from Irvington Place to James Avenue
- 6) Gorham Place from Buckingham Drive to Highcrest Road
- 7) Pelham Road from Irvington Place to James Avenue
- 8) Stratford Avenue from Burrmont Road to Buckingham Drive
- 9) Mattis Avenue from 4th Street to Saner Avenue
- 10) Pershing Avenue from Sewell Street to Horton Street
- 11) Pershing Avenue from 15th Street to 16th Street
- 12) Ranger Street from Kishwaukee Street to Saner Avenue
- 13) Sawyer Road from 10th Street to 11th Street
- 14) Carolina Avenue from Ohio Parkway to Oregon Avenue
- 15) Constance Drive from Wisconsin Road to Colorado Avenue
- 16) Hillside Court from 25th Street to 26th Street
- 17) Seward Avenue from Dakota Avenue to Wyoming Drive
- 18) Forest View Avenue from 26th Avenue to Waukegan Drive
- 19) Forest View Avenue from Dexter Street to City Limits
- 20) Manhattan Drive from Eastlawn Drive to End of Manhattan Drive
- 21) Woodridge Drive from Javelin Drive to Cul-de-sac
- 22) Yale Drive from Rutgers Place to Concordia Drive

Alleyway Resurfacing with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) Alley 337 from 1800 Block of 2nd Avenue to Hutchins Avenue

- 2) Alley 357 from 0100 Block of Paris Avenue to Rome Avenue
- 3) Alley 358 from 0100 Block of Rockford Avenue to Welty Avenue
- 4) Alley 741 from 0600 Block of Prospect Street to Bohm Avenue
- 5) Alley 748 from 0600 Block of Prospect Street to Bohm Avenue
- 6) Jackson Street from Prospect Street to Alley
- 7) Alley 780 from 0500 Block of Lafayette Avenue to Prairie Avenue
- 8) Alley 803 from 0300 Block of Y Boulevard to Whitman Street Bridge

Bituminous Patching with curb and gutter, sidewalk, ADA ramps, driveway approaches, and structure repairs as needed at the following locations:

- 1) Pershing Avenue at the intersection of Pershing Avenue and Hansen Street
- 2) Pershing Avenue from 16th Street to 17th Street
- 3) Ohio Parkway various locations on Ohio Parkway from Broadway to East Gate Parkway
- 4) Wesleyan Avenue from 25th Street to 26th Street

Reconstruct roadway with 10" aggregate base and 4" bituminous surface at the following locations:

- 1) Phaeton Drive reconstruct area between 6167 and 6189 Phaeton Drive

CITY WIDE SIDEWALK AND ADA REPAIRS
PACKAGE #1- 2014

BLACKHAWK PARK AVENUE & SEMINARY STREET
REHABILITATION PROJECT

Work began on Phase 2 of the Blackhawk Park Avenue & Seminary Street Rehabilitation Project on April 23.

Phase 1, consisting of the rehabilitation of Seminary Street from Harrison Avenue to Blackhawk Park Avenue, was completed in fall 2013.

Phase 2 consists of the rehabilitation of Blackhawk Park Avenue from Seminary Street to Kishwaukee Street and includes the Seminary Street and Blackhawk Park Avenue intersection. The rehabilitation includes removal of the existing concrete pavement, full-depth hot-mix asphalt pavement installation, curb & gutter replacement, inlet adjustments, and sidewalk and driveway replacement within the right of way. During Phase 2 Blackhawk Park Avenue will be open to westbound one-way traffic. For eastbound traffic a detour will be posted. The Phase 2 anticipated completion date is late June 2014.

Drivers are encouraged to consider alternate routes during the project construction. Drivers are also reminded to obey work zone speed limits and to stay alert for workers when driving through the construction zone.
