MESSAGE

On April 10th, 2013 shortly before 7:00 PM, Rockford Police patrol officers responded to the intersection of Benton and Regan in reference to an Armed Robbery to a taxi cab driver. Upon arrival to the area, one of the responding officers observed the suspect fleeing on foot from the scene. Officers took the suspect into custody after a foot chase. A firearm was recovered during the incident. The firearm that was recovered was stolen out of Tennessee.

Rockford Police Detectives conducted follow up investigation into the incident. The suspect was charged with the following:

Danny R. Dees, 18 years of age, Rockford, Illinois
Armed Robbery
Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon
Possession of a Stolen Firearm
Resisting Arrest

Dees is currently on Probation in Winnebago County for Burglary.

The charges against Dees are merely accusations. He is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.

Due to ongoing investigation, a photograph of Dees is not being released at this time.
