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NORTH MAIN & AUBURN ROUNDABOUT & WEST STATE ST CORRIDOR PROJECTS RECEIVE HONORS

ROCKFORD – On Friday, February 7, 2014, Hanson Professional Services and Missman, Inc. were recognized at the 2014 American Council of Engineering Companies (ACEC) engineering excellence awards for their work on two transformative projects in the City of Rockford.

Hanson Professional Services received an Honor Award in the “Transportation” category for their Phase I & II design for the North Main & Auburn Roundabout project. Missman, Inc. received an Honor Award in the “Studies, Research and Consulting” category for their work coordinating the Phase I Engineering on the West State Street Corridor project.

The ACEC sponsors the annual engineering awards for civil engineering and design projects conducted by companies located in Illinois. These awards are typically recognized as the highest industry honors available within the state. This year’s award banquet was conducted in Bloomington-Normal.
