MESSAGE

Members of the Rockford Police Department's M3 Streets Team received information from a concerned citizen that drugs were being sold from the upper apartment at 427 9th St. M3 Officers initiated an investigation and it concluded when the M3 Streets Team executed a search warrant on 4/21/13. The current residents were located inside the apartment. A search of the apartment yielded in excess of 3 lbs. of suspected cannabis and United States currency.

Charges: Violation Cannabis Control Act - Possession with Intent to Deliver, Violation of Controlled Substances Act – Possession of Cocaine, Unlawful Use of a Weapon, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

Arrested: Heidi J. Kolff 48, Rockford

Charges: Violation Cannabis Control Act - Possession with Intent to Deliver Violation of Controlled Substances Act – Possession of Cocaine, Unlawful Use of a Weapon, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.
