MESSAGE

Members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit received information from a concerned citizen as well as a Crimestopper tip that drugs were being sold from apartment #7 at 2305 School St. Detectives initiated an investigation and it concluded when the Narcotics Unit executed a search warrant on 4/2/13. Four individuals were located inside the apartment, including Maxine Russell. Russell was named in the original complaint as being involved with selling. Russell is currently on probation in Winnebago County for a previous case in which Russell was arrested for selling crack cocaine. A search of the apartment yielded 13 individual bags of suspected crack cocaine that were hidden inside the apartment as well as United States currency. As detectives were searching the apartment, a female, who was identified as Dominique Lambert, attempted to force her way inside the apartment and struck one of the detectives in the head with the door. Dominique Lambert was taken into custody after continuing to struggle with officers. Another individual that was located inside the apartment was identified as Javan Lambert. Lambert is currently on parole for a previous drug conviction. Russell, Dominique Lambert, and Javan Lambert were all arrested for the below listed charges and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.
