### MESSAGE

On April 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2013 at approximately 2:50 PM, Rockford Police Officers received a call from a concerned citizen who advised having observed an unknown male subject crawling through a rear window of a neighbor's home located in the 800 block of Garfield Avenue. The responding officers observed a bicycle beneath the rear window. The officers observed a subject within the residence. At first this subject refused to exit, but then co-operated and exited via the front door where he was taken into custody.

Detectives conducted follow up investigation determining the subject was involved in an additional residential burglary occurring at 1000 Harlem Blvd. Stolen property was recovered from the prior Residential Burglary.

As a result of this investigation, the suspect was charged with the following:

**Lewis, Tyrone M. 19 years of age, Rockford, Illinois**  
**2 Counts of Residential Burglary (800 Garfield Avenue and 1000 Harlem Blvd)**

It should be noted that all charges are accusations, and the accused should be considered innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
