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### *ARTERIAL PAVEMENT STRIPING*

The Public Works Department will continue to perform arterial pavement striping on the following roadways the week of August 8, 2011:

11<sup>th</sup> St. / Charles St. to Harrison Ave.  
15<sup>th</sup> Ave. / Main St. to 15<sup>th</sup> St.  
15<sup>th</sup> St. / Broadway to 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave.  
18<sup>th</sup> Ave. / Christina to 15<sup>th</sup> St.  
18<sup>th</sup> St. / Charles St. to Broadway  
1<sup>st</sup> St. / Walnut to Jefferson  
23<sup>rd</sup> Ave. / Kishwaukee to 20<sup>th</sup> St.  
20<sup>th</sup> St. / Samuelson to E. State St.  
2<sup>nd</sup> St. / N 2<sup>nd</sup> to Walnut  
6<sup>th</sup> St. / Benton to 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave.  
7<sup>th</sup> St. / 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. to 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave.  
7<sup>th</sup> St. / 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. to Charles  
9<sup>th</sup> St. / Harrison to Crosby  
Christina / 15<sup>th</sup> Ave. to Blackhawk Park  
College Ave. / Seminary to Kishwaukee  
Charles St. / State St. to Alpine Rd.

The operation is dependent on existing weather conditions and is subject to change accordingly.

Arterial pavement striping will continue during the months of July thru September.

Citizens are urged to approach striping crews at a reduced speed that is below posted speed limits. Proceed with caution traveling into the lane adjacent to the pavement striping and maintain a safe distance. Changing lanes in close proximity to the

pavement striping crew is not recommended. Recent changes in EPA Regulations have mandated that manufacturers remove solvent based driers from striping paint, thus creating extended drying times. Your cooperation is appreciated.
