### MESSAGE

Members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit have been investigating the sale of illegal narcotics which had been reported to be taking place at 527 N. 2<sup>nd</sup> St. As a result of this investigation a search warrant was obtained and executed on 09/27/11 by the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit. Several adults were located in the apartment. During a search of the residence detectives located several individually wrapped pieces of suspected crack cocaine along with United States currency. One adult female, later identified as Latasha J. Taylor, was charged with Possession with intent to deliver 1-15 grams of cocaine. Taylor was lodged in the Winnebago County Jail.

Arrested: Taylor, Latasha J. 24, Rockford

Charges: Possession with intent to deliver 1-15 grams of cocaine within 1,000 feet of a Church.

Bond: \$150,000

Taylor is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
