## MESSAGE

On Thursday, October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2009 a joint effort between the Rockford Police Department, the Illinois State Police Zone 2 Investigations Unit and Parole Agents from the Illinois Department of Corrections conducted sex offender compliance checks. There was a total of 97 subjects checked and of these (3) were found not to be in compliance with registration requirements. As a result arrest warrants were authorized by the Winnebago County States Attorneys office for Failure to Register as a Sex Offender for the below listed subjects:

- 1) Carl E. White (Jr.) - B/M – 07-14-78 – Bond \$100,000 (10 % applies)
- 2) Clark S. Wilson    - W/M – 01-06-63 – Bond \$100,000 (10% applies)
- 3) Dennis Walker     - B/M – 12-05-60 – Bond \$100, 000 (10% applies)
