MESSAGE

Members of the Rockford Police Department's Narcotics Unit have been investigating the sale of illegal narcotics at 526 N. Court St., lower apartment. As a result of this investigation a search was obtained and executed on 10/05/09. Two adults were located inside the residence. During a search of the apartment officers recovered crack cocaine and cannabis. Both of the drugs were packaged separately and for individual sale. In addition to the drugs, detectives also recovered ammunition and United States currency. One of the subjects, who we identified as Barry L. Lockett, was arrested and lodged in the Winnebago County Jail. The other adult was released without charge.

Arrested: Lockett, Barry L. 44, Rockford

Charge: Possession with intent to deliver cocaine within 1,000 feet of church, Possession with intent to deliver cannabis, Unlawful Use of Weapon by Felon.

Bond: To be set by Judge (Felony charge)

Lockett is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.
