

### **11<sup>th</sup> STREET RECONSTRUCTION** **HARRISON TO BROADWAY**

Road work is continuing on the portion of 11<sup>th</sup> Street from Harrison Avenue to 18th Avenue, and will be closed to traffic (please see attached map). The closure will remain in place until the contractor gets everything completed to safely reopen the road to live traffic for the winter months. The scheduled date to reopen the road for the winter through the entire length of the project limits will be Wednesday, November 26. Two-way traffic remains in place from 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Broadway until the reopening date of November 26. Once reopened, the portion of 11<sup>th</sup> Street from Columbia Avenue to Broadway will remain two lane traffic in each direction and the portion of newly reconstructed 11<sup>th</sup> Street from Columbia Avenue to Harrison Avenue will narrow down to one lane in each direction. Please be mindful of these changes to the new traffic lane patterns.

### **DAVIS PARK IMPROVEMENTS**

The Davis Park Improvement project started on September 30, 2025. The Davis Park at Founders Landing is under construction and closed for public use. Completion of the Davis Park Improvement project is scheduled to be completed the Spring of 2026.

This project consists of site improvements along with new building installations. The site improvements include seawall repair, river walk realignments, multiuse path improvements, custom playground installation, skatepark installation, grading and landscaping improvements, and installation of a new parking lot south of the Railroad tracks. The new building installations include a concession and multi-restroom building and a stage with greenroom building.

All appropriate traffic control measures and marked detour routes will be in place to help safely guide traffic. Those using the river walk path will be detoured to S. Main Street on the north and south end of Davis Park.

This project is funded by State grants and City funds.

### **STREET DIVISION MAINTENANCE UPDATE**

The fall street sweeping season began on Monday, September 15, 2025. Arterial routes and mini islands are complete, and crews started work on the residential routes September 23, 2025.

The following area are scheduled to be swept the week beginning November 24, 2025.

- Kishwaukee St east to S Alpine Rd - Broadway north to Charles St
- 7th St east to S Alpine Rd - Charles St north to E State St

Each Thursday throughout the residential sweeping season, weekly updates will be provided to highlight the residential areas of the city where street sweepers will be working. Maps will also be included to provide a visual of areas completed, not completed and those in progress.


